Over the past three weeks, Chris W. Eskridge has contacted numberous individuals concerning the death of Laura Aime.

Various pieces of information have been followed up on and the following facts have been determined.

- 1. The last known person to see Laura alive was Thomas
 Jones of American Fork, who saw Laura in the the American Fork
 City park on October 31, 1974, around midnight.
- 2. Bryan Southwick of Lehi saw Laura by Jack&Jills
 Bowling Alley in American Fork on October 31, 1974 at 11:00 p.m.
 Laura was hitchiking north at the time along U.S. 89.
- 3. Laura had been in Orem in the evening of October 31, 1974, partying with Cheryl and Joley Strater, Larry Stowe and Steven Bullock at Steven Bullocks trailer in Orem. She stated to Cheryl Strater that she (Laura) was going to hitchike to Lehi and would Cheryl please come with her. Cheryl refused, but Laura Went anyway. Nowhere specific was mentioned as to where she was going.
- 4. Laura and her friends often visited Brown's Restaurant in Lehi. This is where I suspect Laura was headed on October 31, 1974. Browns was a hang out for kids and was always a place of action. She may have also planned to stop at the Bryants home.
- 5. The suspect frequently visited Browns when the store was managed by the Ewing family (who took over in January of 1975), but the suspect was not recognized by the former manager nor worker who ran the store in the October-November 1974 time frame.
- 6. Laura attended a party at Lee McClures house in Pleasant Grove with Brian Bloomquist and then she and Brian went to Lehi to a party for Luke at Kirk Bryants home. These events transpired on or about October 21, 1974, and not in November 1974 as thought previously.
- 7. There is no record of the suspect being stopped for field interviews or any other offense in Lehi, American Fork, Pleasant Grove, nor Orem.
- 8. No record of the suspect staying in any boarding house in American Fork nor in the Maple Hills Motel in Pleasant Grove. (One suspicious registration card from the Maple Hills Motel is enclosed.)

9. The suspect often came into Browns Restaurant in Lehi with a friend. The friend drove a blue-green late model truck, was approximately 6'1" and slender. They frequently visited Browns when the Ewings were the managers, this being from January 1975 through the summer months of 1975:

I suspect that Laura continued hitchiking toward Lehi but was picked up along U.S. 89 somewhere between where the road divides on the north end of American Fork and the Bryants home.

This is a long, not frequently traveled, dark straightaway road.

We should determine if the suspect has or had access to any cabins in Utah's mountain regions and subsequently if he or his vehicle was seen frequenting the area last November.

and through Milton K. Blakey, Deputy District Attorney, and presents to the Court the following statement of facts as an offer of proof of the two similar transactions set out in the Peoples Notice of Intent to Offer Additional Similar Transactions. The People submit this Offer of Proof to be considered by the Court in determining as a matter of law, considering this offer in a light most favorable to the People, the admissibility of these similar transactions in the trial of the above entitled cause.

SIMILAR TRANSACTION No. 1

Kent, seventeen year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Dean Kent of 24 East 3500 South, Bountiful, Utah, disappeared from Viewmont High School in Bountiful, Utah. Since that date neither her family nor any of her acquaintances have had any contact with her, she has not been seen by anyone who can positively identify her, and her body has never been found.

Testimony will show that Mr. and Mrs. Dean Kent and Debra Kent attended a play at Viewmont High School on the evening of November 8, 1974. They arrived there at approximately 8:00 p.m. on that date. Approximately 10:10 p.m., Mr. Kent gave Debra the keys to the family car and sent her to pick up her two brothers from the skating rink and to come back and pick up her parents at

the school after the program. The evidence will show that they waited for some time for her to come back, and when she did not return they went to the parking lot and discovered their car was still there and had not been moved. At that time they contacted friends who brought them a key so that Mr. Kent could pick up the boys. After picking up their two sons, the Kents reported Debra's disappearance at approximately 11:55 p.m. The Kent family and their friends checked the area in the vicinty of Viewmont High School and the near by canyons, as did the police, all with negative results.

The evidence will show that at the time Debra Kent was last seen on November 8, 1974 she was seventeen years of age, 5'1" in height, 110 pounds with long brown hair, parted in the middle, brown eyes, oval shaped face, and was wearing white pants with a blue sweater having a flowered design and a blue "Ike" jacket.

The evidence will show that Debra Kent was a very reliable girl with a sound and stable relationship with her parents who always notified her parents of her whereabouts. The evidence will further show that during an intermission in the program that she had talked to a friend who will indicate that from their discussion she could detect no problems. All was well.

The evidence will show that Mr. Orval Ryver, 1195 North 200 West, Bountiful, Utah, heard a girl scream several times very loudly at approximately 10:55 p.m. on November 8, 1974 as he was arriving home from work. Mr. Ryver's testimony would indicate that the screams sounded kind of desperate. The evidence will also indicate that he then saw the lights of a mid size car leaving the west drive way of Viewmont High School.

The evidence will indicate that Linda J. Olson of 154 West 10th North, a location also near the Viewmont High School, heard three very loud screams which she described as a girls voice which "sounded as through she was really scared," at approximatly 10:20 p.m. on November 8, 1974.

Drive #4, heard a loud explosion which came from the front of Viewmont High School at approximately 10:45 p.m. on November 8, 1974 and that at approximately 11:00 p.m. he heard screams coming from the Viewmont area. Mr. Lakin left his apartment to investigate this incident and went to Viewmont because he thought someone was really in trouble.

Further evidence will indicate that Mr. George L. Bates, 997 North Chapel Drive #6, heard a girl yell or scream which to him sounded rather bad at approximately 10:30 p.m. on November 8, 1974.

Further evidence will indicate that Mr. and Mrs. Portrey, 971 North Chapel Drive #2, were at their resident and heard a loud bang and a girl scream at a time between 10:45 p.m. and 11:15 p.m. on November 8, 1974.

Evidence will also indicate that a Linda Lakin, 971 Chapel Drive #4, heard a blast or pop and a girl scream at approximately 10:55 p.m. on November 8, 1974.

The evidence will show that there are other witnesses in addition to those already mentioned who heard a bang and heard a girl's screams at time between 10:30 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on November 8, 1974.

The Peoples evidence will indicate that on November 9, 1974, a grid search of the entire area around Viewmount High School was conducted and that during that search Officer Loring, found a handcuff key just outside the sidewalk in front of the east door of the school. The evidence will further indicate that this key was taken by Officer Beal, of the Bountiful Police Department to the Murray Police Department where it was tried in a set of handcuffs in the custody of Murray City Police Department which handcuffs were recovered on November 8, 1974 from the wrist of Carol DaRonch, a kidnap victim that same evening. This key fit perfectly and operated the handcuffs recovered from the wrist of Miss DaRonch.

The evidence will indicate that Catherine Ricks, 245 Chase Lane, was at the play at Viewment on November 8, 1974 and was approached by an individual had approximately 9:50 p.m. Ms. Ricks would indicate that this individual was approximately 30 to 35 years of age, 5'10" to 6' tall, with dark curly hair medium cut, with dark plastic rimmed glasses, dark blue suit and tie, possibly a shirt jacket, of medium build. Ms. Ricks would indicate that this individual asked her if she knew a boy (whose name she can not remember). That she told him "No" whereupon he stated that this was his brother. She asked him if he (the boy) went to school there. He stated, he didn't know, "I don't keep that good of track of him." He then told her that he had car trouble and he needed her to help him. Whereupon she stated that she didn't know him. He then asked her if she would come out and hold an item on his car while he attempted to start his car. She told him that she would not and then reentered the auditorium.

Another person, Rae Lynn Shepard will indicate that she had contact with a man in the hall at approximately 7:55 p.m. as she was going up the east hall by the side of the auditorium. At this time, he asked her to help him. He asked her to come outside and identify a car for him. She stated that she did not have the time. She then went to the dressing room and approximately fifteen (15) minutes later she came back down the hall and he was still standing there, at this time she said "Hi", to him, however, he said nothing back. Again at approximately 8:45 p.m. she again met him in the hall-way and he made the statement "Are you sure you won't come and identify that car for me?" She again stated "No." When she came from the dressing room at approximately 9:00 to 9:15 p.m., he left the school by going out the west door on the front of the school near the auto shop area. The next time she saw him he was leaning over the rail at the back of the school in the auditorium and was breathing very heavily, his hair was messed up and he appeared to be very upse. He sat down across the aisle from her

and her husband. This was at approximately 10:40 p.m. At this time, there were curtain calls in the play. He got up just prior to the end of the curtain calls and left going out the front door.

Mrs. Shepard also recalled that during one of the conversations he asked her 'if she knew a Brent Olson, she asked. if he was a student and he stated, he didn't know, he just thought he might live in the area and she might know him.

Mrs. Shepard would describe the individual she is referring to as a white male, 6' to 6'1", 180 to 185 lbs., well built, 34 to 36 years of age, brown hair 2 1/2" to 3" long, parted on the left side. A mustache going down the sides of the mouth, large round shiny eyes, arched eyebrows, quit thick, wearing light colored pants, tight in the thigh area and flaring at the bottom, with a dark suit coat and tie and patent leather shoes. She would indicate he was well built, very good looking and walked with a long stride.

On October 2, 1975, a physical lineup was held at Metropolitan Law Building, 431 South 300 East, Salt Lake City, Utah. There were eight (8) individuals in the lineup, including Theodore Robert Bundy. Rae Lynn Shepard viewed that lineup and identified Theodore Robert Bundy as the man that she described seeing in Viewmont High School on November 8, 1974.

Further evidence will indicate that Tami Tingey, age seventeen (17), talked with Debra Kent during the intermission in the girls restroom. From what Tami Tingey could tell with talking with Debra, all was well with her and Debra was acting her usual self. Tami Tingey's testimony would indicate at approximately ten minutes after the intermission, she got up from her seat in the auditorium and went to the rear of the autditorium and stood back there talking with another girl friend. During this time, she observed a man walking back and forth in the rear. Her decription of this individual was between 27 and 28 years of age, good looking, height between 6'& 6'1", approximately 180 pounds, with dark brown hair, almost

black, and a mustacje that came down on both sides nearly to his lower lip. Her testimony would indicate he was wearing a blue jacket, white shirt and possibly a tie. Her testimony would indicate that this man hung around the area by the doors which led out to the south with his arms folded and appeared to be an individual in authority acting somewhat as an usher.

On October 2, 1975, a physical lineup was held at Metropolitan Law Building, 431 South 300 East, Salt Lake City, Utah. There were eight individuals in the lineup including Theodore Robert Bundy. Tami Tingey viewed that lineup and identified Theodore Robert Bundy as the man that she described seeing in Viewmont High School on November 8, 1974.

SIMILAR TRANSACTION NO. 2

In the State's offer of proof, testimony and exhibits will be introduced indicating the following. Laura Ann Aime was last seen on October 31, 1974 at a halloween party where her and several friends got together and consumed alcohol. Along towards midnight, Laura Ann Aize indicated that she wished to go downtown to buy a pack of cigarettes. She wanted to hitch hike. One of her friends refused to go down with her. Laura Ann Aime left by herself. That was the last time she was seen. When she left the halloween party, she was wearing a halter top and blue levis with patches on the rear. There is no indication whether or not she was wearing shoes at this time. There will be testimony that she was not wearing nvolns. Laura had consumed a considerable amount of alcohol and supposedly was going to hitch hike down to American Fork. In the middle of November, two of her friends thought they had recieved a phone call from her.

In Amercian Fork Canyon, Utah. The area is described as a mountain area. At that time there was no snow on the ground; but it was completely frozen and covered with leaves. American Fork Canyon is a recreational area with a lot of brush and trees in the area. When the body was found, it was completely nude with the exception of a necklace and a ring with a green stone in it. There was a nyoln tightly wrapped around her neck, which had been used as a chocking device. Her body was found by a young man and young lady who were hiding in the area. They saw a light blue volkswagon in the area at the same time. Laura Ann Aime's body was taken from the scene to the office of the medical examiner where an autopsy was performed at approximately 5:00 p.m. on November 27, 1974.

The autopsy revealed the following:

Multiple contused lacerations of scalp;

Depressed fracture of skull: 2.

Fracture of the left ramus of the 3. Multiple areas of ecchymoses of the ears and

retroauricular area;

Epidural and subdural hemorrhage, bilateral; 5.

ultiple contusions of the brain.

Dittuse, traumatic subarachnoid hemorrhage of 7. the brain:

- 17. Pulmonary edema;

As a general description, the body was that of an unembalmed,

well-developed, well-nourished young adult female between 16 and 18 years of age that measures 5'10" in length and weighs about 110 to 120 pounds. The body was naked and it was covered by multiple leaves, twigs, clusters and clumps of dirt and caked mud. Scalp hair color is dark brown 15" to 17" long, parted in the middle, pubic hair is The axillary hair had been recently shaved and the growth of it was less than 1/8"; the eyes were brown, the shoe size was 7 E, There was a linear scar on the anterior-lateral aspect of the mid- third of the left forearm that measures 1/2" in length. This scar is one identifying mark recognized by James Aime, the father of Laura Ann Aime. James Aime idenitifies the body as that of his daughter, Laura Ann Aime. The autopsy further reveals complexion that is fair to medium with solar hyperpigmentation of the skin of the face, neck, chest, abdomen, upper and lower extremities with areas of non tanning of the skin in the nape and interscapular regions of the back. There is a superficial, irregular, linear abrasion of the skin of the anterior aspect of the neck immediately below the level of the hyoid bone that measures 3/4" in length and has a maximum width of

1/8". There is an irregualr, bloodless abrasions of the left pectoral region immediately below the breast, the anterior-lateral aspect of the right hemithorax and inner aspect of the right arm in an area that has an overall measurement of 4 3/4"x3/4".

There is an irregular bloodless abrasion of the anterior aspect of the left thigh extending from immediately above the left knee cap to the mid third of the left leg in an area that measures 11/2" in length by $6\frac{\pi}{2}$.

There are abrasions to both feet and bloodless abrasion to the right thigh and right gluteal region in an area that measures 11 $1/4^{\prime\prime}$ x 5"

There are also bloodless abrasion on the lower third of the right leg in an area that measures 8 $1/2^{\prime\prime}$ x $3/4^{\prime\prime}$.

The inner aspects of the skin of the thighs next to the labia majora of the vulva shows a "chaffed" bright red surface.

There are bloodless abrasion of the right deltoid region that measures $2\ 1/2$ " in the greatest deameter.

There are four, parallel, superficial linear cutting wounds of the skin of the right supraclavicular region with surrounding subcutaneous hemorrhage that measure between 3/16" to 3/8" in length with a bright red slightly granular surface.

The subungueal region of all fingers in both hands show considerable amount of bright red hemorrhage. The palmar aspect of the fingers is dry and wrinkled and has a dark red-purple appearance.

There is an irregular linear abrasion of the right half of the lower lip that measures 3 1/2" by 2 1/2". Further description of the neck injuries reveal that, tied to the yellow metal chain that forms a ligature around the neck is a brown colored stocking and woven with it are strands of the 15" to 17" long dark brown

hair....

Examination of the neck organs reveal considerable amount of hemorrhage on the underlying subcutaneous tissue as well as the strap muscles of the neck with a fracture of the right ala of the hyoid bone and with considerable amount of hemorrhage into the strap muscles surrounding it. There are petechiae of the mucosal epiglottis and larynx with slight edema of the vocal cords.

The tongue is protruding and is held in situ by the teeth.

There is a moderate amount of frothy red fluid that is seen exuding

from the nostrils and mouth. There is considerable subcutaneous edema with swelling of the lower face and upper neck above the point of the ligature in the neck.

There are ten lacerations of the scalp:

- 1. Is located in the left temporal-parietal region of the scalp, measures 2 1/2" x 1/8", it is a full thickness contused laceration of the scalp exposing the underlying fractured bone. The skin edges are irregular, contused with several bridges of soft tissue intervening between the gaping edges. These are separated between 1/8" to 1/4". The scalp surrounding the wound shows a contused light red, slightly granular surface.
- 2. Is located in the left occipital-temporal region of the scalp, it measures 3/4" x 1/4", the gaping edges are separated 1/1", it is a full thickness of the scalp exposing the underlying fractured bone. The wound edges are contused showing a bright red, irregular surface with several small bridges of soft, light, red tissue intervening between the gaping edges.
- red tissue intervening between the gaping edges.

 3. Measures 1 1/8". It is located in the left temporaloccipital region of the scalp. The gaping edges are separated
 1/2", it is a full thickness of the scalp exposing the underlying
 fractured depressed skull. The borders are contused and show an
 irregular, bright red granular surface.
- 4. Is located in the left temporal region of the scalp, it measures 1" \times 1/4", the borders are irregular, contused and show a bright red granular surface. It involves the superficial layers of the scalp without exposing the underlying bone.
- 5. Is located in the left retroauricular region of the scalp, it measures 1/4", the borders are sharp, separated 1/8", with very sharp right angle borders and an extensive area of surrounding ecchymoses that measures 3 1/2" in the greatest diameter with abrasion of the adjacent skin.
- with abrasion of the adjacent skin.
 6. Is an elliptic, irregular laceration of the mid third of the border of the left ear that measures 3/4"x1/16" exposing the cartilage beneath and with considerable purple-red subepithelial hemorrhage surrounding it.
- 7. Is an elliptic contused laceration of the right retroauricular region that measures 1 5/8"x1/4", the borders are irregular with a bright red granular surface, it includes a full thickness of the scalp without exposing the underlying bone.
- 8. Is an elliptic, irregular, contused laceration of the right retroauricular region of the scalp in an area that measures 1"x3/16", the borders are irregualr, contused, with a bright red granular surface.
- 9. Is an irregular vertical, elliptic contused laceration of the scalp that measures 1/2", the borders are separated 1/16" and include only the superficial portion of the scalp.
- 10. Is immediately below laceration #9, it is an elliptic parallel laceration that measures 1/2".1/16". The borders are contused penetrating through the full thickness of the scalp.

Exhymoses: There is an irregular ovoid area of subcutaneous ecchymoses including most of the left auricualr area and retroauricular area and measures 5"x4" with hemorrhage extending to the earlobe, tragus and helix of the ear. There is also an area of ecchymoses on the right mastoid and right retroauricular region that measures 1 3/4"x4 1/8".

Fractures: There is a complete transverse fracture of the right ala of the hyoid. There is a depressed 5"x4" comminuted fracture of the left temporal and left parental bones underlying the lacerations previously described in the left half of the scalp. There is complete transverse fracture of the left ramus of the mandible at the mid third.

Examination of the genitalia; the pubic hair is brown and matted. The vaginal introitus is non virginal and shows markedly hyperemic bright red borders with a glistening almost oily surface. The vaginal orifice is dilated and contains abundant mucoid light tan to white material. The vaginal canal reveals no foreign bodies. The perineum reveals no other areas of laceration or contusion, excoriation or abrasion of the labia majora or labia minora. The anus is markedly dilated and shows a surrounding hyperemic bright red glistening mucosa with 2" diamete dilated anal ring. The rectum reveals light brown soft fecal material well formed mass about 1 1/2" above the anus.

The internal injuries are confined to the cranium. The areas of hemorrhage extend through the full thickness of the cortex and into the white matter of the brain.

External examination is that the head is symmetric, the scalp was covered by long brown hair 15" to 17" in length, the face reveals injuries aforementioned and the eyes are otherwise not remarkable; they are dark brown and the pupils are equally dilated and the nose is not remarkable.

Nasal bones were not factured and the mouth reveals a moderate amount of serosanguineous exudate exuding freely. The tongue was held in situ by the teeth. The neck revealed the injuries aforementioned. The chest was symmetric. The breasts were well developed. The nipples were everted. There was no discharge noted. There are no subepithelial masses. The abdomen is flat and firm. The back revealed no other adnormality. The genitilia and anus have been described. The upper and lower extremities revealed no other abnormality.

Central nervous system: The brain weights 1600 grams. There were no aneurusms. The middle ears were diffusely hemorrhagic. The cerebral and cerebellar hemispheres were symmetric. There was no abnormal dilatation of lateral ventricles, third or fourth ventricles. There were no free blood within, The spinal cord revealed no other abnormality. The cerebellar hemispheres was oeherwise not remarkable.

The blood type was C positive. All other systems appear normal.

Vaginal smears were positive for non motile sperm in the anus and vagina. The vaginal smear has an acid phosphatase of plus 1000 percent. The anal is positive of 390 units.

Toxicologic tests indicate that the blood alcohol level was at .10%. As was previously noted, Laura Ann Aime's father, identified the body as that of Laura Ann Aime.

If further identification is necessary, there will be testimony on dental comparsions by experts.

There will be testimony that Theodore Robert Bundy knew Laura Ann Aime and they had talked on several occasions. Witnesses will testify that Ted Bundy hung around Brown's cafe, which was frequented also by Laura Ann Aime. Bundy drank coffee and flirted with the girls. Ted Bundy occasionally sat with Laura Ann Aime and her girl friends. On one occasion as Laura Ann Aime was about to leave, Ted Bundy blocked her in a booth and stated "You can't go, I'm going to rape you"; A witness to that, will testify that Laura Ann Aime shoved him out of the booth and left. This occurred in late summer or early fall of 1974. On another occasion, in late September or early October, Laura Ann Aime introduced Ted Bundy to a group of her friends, including Jerry Bowers. Jerry Bowers and Ted Bundy got into an argument after Jerry puts grass in Laura's halter top. Bundy told Jerry to leave Laura alone because Laura was his girl. Laura told Bundy to "Get screwed." Bundy was left speechless.

On another occasion, Ted Bundy went to a house where Laura was visiting. Laura went outside with Ted and became quite upset.

A witness heard Laura tell him "Get the fuck out of here, F don't want to see you no more."

When Laura Ann Aime's body was found, on Thanksgiving Day of 1974, investigators noticed tire tracks in the vicinity of the crime scene. They made plaster casts of the tire tracks, which were later sent to the Colorado Bureau of Investigation.

The Colorado Bureau of Investigation compared those casts to tires on a 1968 volkswagon owned by Ted Bundy in November, 1974.

The comparison reveals that the tires on the volkswagon and the plaster casts tires are of the same width and have the same tread design.

This will be a summary of a suspect developed in the killing of the girls in the Salt Lake area, and possibly into surrounding states, being compiled by Detective Jerry Thompson of the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office, Homicide Division.

The suspect is a THEODORE ROBERT BUNDY, DOB 11-24-46, white male, 5'11", 170 pounds, brown hair, blue eyes. Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office arrest number is 78058.

The subject first basically really came to light in my eyes on 8-16-75 when he was arrested by a Highway Patrol trooper in the early morning hours driving around a subdivision, and in his vehicle he had a satchel full of numerous items—handcuffs, pantihose, a ski mask, strips of rope, a crowbar, an ice pick, etc. His explanation for these items was very poor.

On 8-21-75 this detective picked the subject up from the Salt Lake

County Jail and took him to his apartment at 565 First Avenue #2, where
he signed a consent search of his apartment. A thorough search was made
of the apartment by this detective. Basically, we came up with only three
items—a Colorado map, a brochure from Colorado on the ski resorts in the
state, and a recreational type brochure from a Bountiful recreation center.
also one book called the Joys of Sex. Before finding these particular items,
the subject was asked by this officer if he had ever been to the state of
Colorado, if he had ever been over there skiing. His comment was, "No, that
is one state I have never been in." He was asked if he had ever been in the
town of Bountiful, just north of Salt Lake, and he stated, "Not to my knowledge;
if so, I've just passed through." In finding these items, he was asked by
officer how come he had them. He had another explanation for everything, that
a friend, he couldn't remember who, left them in his apartment, he didn't
know why they were in there. The subject was then asked for his permission

to look through his car and also to take photographs. Photos were taken of his Volkswagen vehicle, which at this time was bearing Utah license LJE 379, on a 68 Volkswagen, registered to the subject. The color was either an off-white or a light brown or light beige. Observed in the vehicle at this time is that it did not have a front bumper nor a front license plate, and that in the back window the back seat on the top had a large tear across the top; also, there was a different paint coloration on the right door and towards the fender. The subject never at anytime asked why or what we wanted any pictures for or anything else. to come into the office the next day and talk to myself and Capt. Hayward, to which he stated he would be more than willing to, again never asking what The very next morning we received a call from his attorney, John O'Connell, who stated that his client would not come in, he had advised him not to come in and talk to us, and he wanted to know what we wanted to talk to Bundy about, we surely didn't think that he had killed all these girls. He was informed negative, we just wanted to talk to him.

From this point on, a more thorough investigation went into the individual by myself; Mike Fisher from the District Attorney's Office in Aspen, Colorado; Sgt. Bill Baldridge from the Pitkin County Sheriff's Office in Colorado; Milo Vig from the Mesa County Sheriff's Office in Grand Junction Colorado; and Lt. Ron Ballantine from the Bountiful City Police Department and the rest of his staff; and Robert Keppel from the King County Sheriff's Office in Seattle, Washington, and his staff. It was then learned from Mike Fisher from Colorado, where he obtained some charge receipt invoices from Chevron Oil, after having been given Bundy's credit card number by this detective, and came up with the first 6 months of 1975's charge cards. The rest had been subpoenaed by this detective and are awaiting arrival, for the years of 1973, all of 1974, and the current 1975. It was observed at

this time, however, of particular notice that on 1-12-75 the subject bought gasoline in Glenwood Springs, Colorado, two times on this date. This is the date in question when CARYN CAMPBELL turned up missing and was killed out of Aspen, Colorado. Glenwood Springs is just a short distance from Again of particular notice, on 3-15-75 the subject was observed Aspen. buying gas in Golden, Colorado; also on the same date in Silver Thorne, Colorado; and the same date in Dillon, Colorado. This is the date when JULIE CUNNINGHAM turned up missing from Vale, Colorado, and has never been seen or heard from since. These towns are all within a very short distance of the ski resort. Again, in April of 1975, on the 4th, it was observed that the subject bought gas in Golden, Colorado; in the 5th in Silver Throne, Colorado; on the 6th in Grand Junction, Colorado. This is the date when DENISE OLIVERSON from Grand Junction, Colorado, turned up missing and has never been heard from or seen since. Her bicycle was recovered along Bundy's whereabouts other than that are not known, other than that a street. he was living in the Salt Lake area during October and November, the time that are girls were missing, and that he was living in Seattle, Washington, in the early part of 1974, when the 7 or 9 girls were missing up there.

In an attempt to learn more about this individual, a subpoena was served on Mountain Bell by this detective, and I obtained telephone receipts of his long distance phone calls. Ones of particular notice were to a Dr. R.N. HIRST in Ogden, Utah, phone 394-9230; and ELIZABETH KLOEPFER, who lives at 5208 18th N.E. in Seattle, Washington, phone 206-525-4494. Several others were noted and are on record, but these two are of significant value. In checking out the call to Dr. Hirst in Ogden, it was learned that this subject is the father of Bundy's girlfriend, Elizabeth Kleopfer, and that he was familiar with the subject. An interview was made with the doctor by this

detective and Lt. Ron Ballantine. From this interview it was determined that it would be of great value to interview his daughter in Seattle, Washington.

On 9-17-75 this detective, Detective Ira Beal from Bountiful Police Department, and Detective Dennis Couch from the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office went to Seattle and talked to Elizabeth Kloepfer. It was of particular interest to this officer that his girlfriend had numerous doubts about him, going back to when the girls turned up missing in the Seattle area and had at that time contacted the King County Sheriff's Office with her suspicions. Her suspicions first started approximately June or July of 1974 when Seattle put out a composite which resembled Ted very much, according to her, and also that the subject's name was Ted. From then on she claims that she found numerous items in her apartment which were unexplained, like plaster of Paris, elastic bandages, which the subject so called used up in the Seattle area, which Bundy could not explain to her. She also found a meat cleaver, an ax, and a large knife in her apartment, which he could not explain to her Her lug wrench from her Volkswagen was taken out of the trunk and it was taped about halfway up and put in the front seat of her vehicle. He told her that that was in case she ever needed it. He was observed on other numerous occasions of going out during the middle of the night most of the time, and one particular time he hid an object in his pocket, which she later found out to be surgical gloves. She claimed that he napped a lot during the day and was out during the night; that he followed her and her girlfriends and seemed to like to jump out or come out from behind the bushes and grab them just to scare them. Things from here had just built up, and in Liz's opinion, she is still very fearful of the individual and believes that he is the one involved. His sexual habits, according to her,

have changed tremendously. She has known him for six years, and just this last year his sex habits have changed considerably, which is on another Another girlfriend in the Seattle area was confronted about him, MARY LYNN CHINO, DOB 2-16-45, who lives at 914 West Emerson in Seattle, home phone 282-8289. She more or less substantiates the same feelings as Liz does about the subject. Between the two of them it was found that his family background goes as follows: his father is a cook at Ft. in Washington; his mother is a secretary at Pugeot Sound University; they do not have a lot of money; there are five or six brothers and sister in the family; they are originally from Vermont or Pennsylvania; they apparently came to Seattle in 1969. The subject was told by a cousin that he was an illegitimate child and that his parents have never really told him that; they claim that has had quite a bearing on his life. claim that the subject is a petty thief and he has stolen televisions and numerous items up there; that he is an individual that has a champagne diet and a beer income, he does not have money. In fact, at the present time he needs money badly for his tuition. He asked his girlfriend for \$700.00 to help pay attorneys' fees. This subject does have a college degree from the University of Washington, a B.S. degree in Psychology. He is presently attending the University of Utah in Law School. been quite prominent in the Republican Committee in the Seattle area and the Governor Evans' campaign in 1972. He appears to be definitely a loner, according to everyone we have contacted. We have been unable to come up with any close friends at this time, other than Elizabeth, his girlfriend. They claim he has a tremendous personality when he first meets people, but shortly after you can see through him and the fact that he likes to use They all described him as very educated, a very handsome individual,

and a tremendous personality.

An around-the-clock surveillance has been put on the subject by our office and Bountiful Police Department in an attempt to locate or come up with friends or associates. We have been unable to come up with this, even during our surveillance. We did come up with the information that he joined the Mormon Church a month or so ago and went to one of their overnight outings at Sweetwater in Bear Lake, Utah. He appeared to stay for the most part alone up there. He does not appear to have any close friends that we have been able to come up with up there either. We have come up with one possible girlfriend, a MARGUERITE CHRISTINE MAUGHAN, DOB 3-20-47, who lives in the same apartment complex at 565 First Avenue apartment 1 in the basement. She was observed with this individual on two or three occasions. It should also be noted that she does have an arrest record with our office for Possession of Narcotics and a Shoplifting charge.

That basically is all that we know about the subject at this time.

On 11-8-74 a CAROL DaRONCH was abducted from the area of the Fashion Place Mall this evening in a Volkswagen she describes as an older model, light in color, with a large tear in the back seat across the top. Also, there was a discoloration or some type of marking on the right door and fender. The subject attempted to handcuff her and got both handcuffs on He also produced a small calibre weapon, unknown on the one wrist. calibre, and at one time produced what she describes as an 8 sided lug - wrench, or something to that effect. Since that time, this detective showed this victim numerous pictures, approximately 40, with the suspect She pulled out Bundy's picture, giving all the rest back, stating Bundy. she had not seen the individual in there. When questioned about the one in her hand, she stated, "I don't know why I pulled it out, I guess its because he looks like him." She was then shown the photos that I took of the subject's car. She stated that in her opinion it was the same color, the same type of tear in the back window, and the only thing she could tell me was that looked like the vehicle that she was in. Since that time, Bountiful Police Department officers showed her a group of drivers license pictures, along with the subject, and she pulled out the suspect's picture, stating, "I believe that's the man, but I cannot be positive." taken up in an attempt to eyeball the vehicle in person. At this time the subject had put in a new back seat or else had the back seat repaired, there is no tear in the back of it. He has put on the front bumper and the license plate. The hubcaps are changed from what originally photographed by this detective, and it appears that the vehicle has been painted a darker brown color than originally painted. Also, the Bountiful Police Department took both photos of the subject and showed them to their witnesses at the

Bountiful High School, who saw the so-called suspicious person on the night of the DEBBIE KENT disappearance. They pulled a drivers license and mug shot photo from a group of others out and stated, "If you would put a mustache on the man I would say that that was him."

It should also be noted that the subject's attorney, John O'Connell, called Bob Keppel, King County Sheriff's Office in Seattle, Washington, and made the comment to him that the police in Salt Lake were harrassing or bothering his client and that he wanted to know basically if they thought he was involved in the killing of the girls in that area, that his client definitely was not and that his client would be more than willing to come in there and talk to them about this if this is what they were looking at him for. They informed him that he could come in and talk with them anytime and they would be more than happy to talk to him about anything. What the Salt Lake authorities were doing here, they did not know and they suggested that he talk to the Salt Lake police. They stated it appeared that he was more or less fishing wanting some information about what we knew about his client.

Also it should be noted that a Detective <u>Bob Denning</u> from <u>Clear Creek</u>

<u>County Sheriff's Office in Golden</u>, <u>Colorado</u>, contacted this officer and stated that they had found a nude female down in a mine shaft late in August and it was determined that she turned up missing around July 1 or July 2 of this year. He was inquiring if we had any information that this subject was in that town at this time. I do not have July records from the Chevron Oil Company to see if he was over there in July. They are in the process of obtaining them now. He was in the Golden, Colorado, area however on two occasions, one in March and one in April. A copy of his report is being sent over in regards to his case.

Since the surveillance on the subject, another subpoena was obtained for the records of Mr. Bundy from the Unversity of Utah. It was served on the Assistant Dean Bruce Zimmerman, and a copy of his entire student folder has been obtained and is in our file at this time. Also, Standard Oil Company of California has sent the year of 1974 gas receipts and all of 1973 receipts to me. The year of 1973 puts the individual solely in the Seattle, Washington, area. 1974 from January through August also puts him up there. The month of September, he does a lot of travelling through the Washington area, headed from Idaho, down into the Salt Lake area. It should also be noted that he did purchase gas on 9-26-74 in Murray, Utah, and on 9-24 in Murray Utah. In October, on 10-14-74, he purchased gas in Murray, and on 10-28-74 he purchased gas in Bountiful, Utah. The rest of the tickets are all Salt Lake. From November of 1974 till June of 1975, the gas purchases are related earlier in this summary. July's gas purchases have not yet come from Standard Oil.

On October 1, 1975, a Court Order requesting Mr. Bundy into a line-up for October 2, 1975, was obtained and served on him this date, 10-1-75 at about 3:30 p.m. in his apartment. He seemed extremely nervous and upset when this was served on him, and yet he seemed like he was relieved when he found out it was just an order for a line-up. The individual at this time had long hair over the ears, about collar length. The next morning he showed up for the line-up, on 10-2-75 at 9:00 in the morning, and his hair had been cut, it was cut quite short, was not over the ears, and it had a part on it, it was combed to one side. The individual was picked out of this line-up by our Murray victim, CAROL DARONCH, as being the person who kidnapped her. He was also picked out by two witnesses from the Bountiful area, who stated he was the individual who confronted them at Viewmont High

School on November 8, 1974, the night that DEBRA KENT turned up missing, and she has never been seen since. The subject was arrested a short time later this date, 10-2-75, by this detective for Aggravated Kidnap and Attempted Criminal Homicide with \$100,000.00 bail. When the individual was confronted that he was under arrest by this officer, again, after being told what he was arrested for, it seemed like a great relief to him. His only comment was something like - "Is that all?" And from that point on he has been observed as being extremely relaxed compared to his condition previously.

The very next day a search warrant was obtained and was served on his apartment at 364 Douglas Street. The only items taken on this search warrant were: 19 cassette tapes, a can with some marijuana seeds in it, and one blue sports coat; no other items of interest were in this apartment.

The apartment does not have near the clothing and items in it that his other apartment had when searched before on a consent search. Another search warrant was obtained for the search and seizure of his 1968 Volkswagen, which he has sold. This was picked up and seized from the person that bought it and it is now being held in my custody until a further search can be made of it.

Since the arrest of Mr. Bundy, several people have called, stating they know the individual. Three in particular were: a <u>BART FARNSWORTH</u>, a <u>GLORIA ANN HOWARD</u>, and an <u>ALAN MATHIES</u>, all law students who were in the same class with Mr. Bundy. They stated that during the fall of 1974 they didn't even know him because he missed so much school, and after the first of the year, possibly in March or a little bit earlier, he came to school and they observed scratches on the side of his face, which appeared to them to have been made by a human. His explanation was that he was riding a horse and got scratched by branches. They stated they did not believe this but did not further question him as he did not seem to think it was a joke.

Also, numerous law professors were interviewed. Their comments of the individual were basically the same, that during the fall of 1974, his first year in law school, the individual was hardly in school at all; he made special arrangements to take tests at the end of the year, and different things. They thought this was highly unusual of the individual. They thought that he was a loner. But other than that, they could not add any light to the matter.

Also, Mike Fisher from Aspen, Colorado, stated that they have had Bundy identified from pictures as buying gas in one of the stations in Golden, Colorado, on two occasions, and that the station attendant there remembers him; a also a coincidence is that one of the girls that was found murdered in a mine shaft in Clear Creek County, Colorado, knows this station attendant well and has been in that station on several times. It is unknown if Bundy was ever there at the time that she was there.

Also, a Detective <u>Harry Hanson</u> from the <u>Tacoma Police Department</u> has stated that they have had Bundy identified from a picture that was put in a newspaper that he was the individual, without a doubt, that raped a girl in Tacoma in November of 1973. Charges are pending on this case at this time.

An attempt to get a court order to obtain the blood from the suspect is being made at this time, and as of October 8, 1975, this is where the investigation stands at this time.
